What happens during the Living Dance International examination?

Dancers will enter the exam room without their teacher in groups of 4.

No audience are allowed in the exam room.

- The LDI examiner will then ask them to perform each of the exercises that they have learnt during their classes throughout the year.
- The examiner will assess their performance and write a report.
- Each dancer will receive their LDI certificate at the Price giving day in November.

What is required?

- 2. Arrange own transportation to Exam Venue on the date of the exam.

Dancer must arrive with a ballet bun. (If her hair is too short then we'll attend to it.)
